e have all been watching with horror the scenes on the news from Ukraine in recent weeks. Or maybe we haven't. Sometimes I've found it hard to watch at all, and I've wondered why. Do I need to pray for more compassion? Is it just that the last couple of years have just worn me out a bit?

Elsewhere in this magazine we have put a bit about Ukraine, and we encourage you to look at the words of Psalm 31, being used by lots of Christians there, if you would like to reflect and pray. I think a miracle would be a good thing to pray for.

Earlier this week someone pointed out to me that the video of one of the songs we have sometimes used in church, a version of the creed, was filmed

in Kyiv a few years ago. You can see people walking through the streets, lovely buildings old and new. You wonder how long some of them will still be there; I'm conscious of the time that has passed between me writing this and you reading it.

Yesterday the creed popped up again when I was reading a book that goes with the course we are doing at the moment about unanswered prayer. Regular readers (hello again to all three of you) will remember me writing about that a couple of months back. The writer points out that the creed is full of miracles: God created everything; Jesus was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of a virgin; he ascended into heaven. It seemed fitting to me that a place now in need of such an extraordinary miracle should have so many of them sung over

There's one more in the song, and in the creed, of course. He rose again, it says. In a way that's our prayer for Kyiv, isn't it, and for the whole of Ukraine. We're praying for an extraordinary miracle: that it might rise again.

Easter says that death isn't the end of the story for any of us; that however it comes, it can never have the last word. Easter says that Jesus rose again, and that we can rise again through faith in him. Easter invites us to pray for a miracle; to believe in miracles; to expect a

We have seen some extraordinary defiance from the Ukrainian people in the face of overwhelming opposition, and that first Easter was a time of defiance too. Jesus faced death and hell and all that was evil in the world. The opposition was overwhelming, and for a while it looked like it had won. But Jesus had done enough miracles to believe in them, and burst from the grave to bring life and light and hope.

That's Easter faith. That's what we believe. That's the name of the song, by the way: This I believe.



Wide

ave you ever had to buy or obtain something, like a piece of furniture, that had to fit in a particular space in a room? Like a settee. Or a book shelf. You want it to fit just so, not too wide, not too narrow, just snug. If you're like me, you measure up, once, twice sometimes three times, before you're satisfied you've got the right measurements. Then do you worry when you've bought the item that you've made the right choice? That it will fit in with the rest of the room, with the rest of your living? The width can be particularly important.

Have you ever thought about how wide God's love is? At Easter we remember how Jesus died. He died an awful death on a cross. With arms spread open wide. You may have seen pictures depicting the scene. The church remembers this when it prays: he opened wide his arms for us on the cross. How many of us have wanted to open our arms wide, when we are reunited with friends or family, after a time away? Arms wide open are welcoming arms. Yet, you say, how could Jesus do this on the cross. How could he welcome anyone? How could he welcome me, today?

As a child I was sent to Sunday School and from a very early age I loved singing. My paternal grandmother encouraged me to sing to her on a Sunday afternoon, the songs I had sung at Sunday School in the morning and one of them I still remember, with the actions, and she would join in with me:

Wide, wide as the ocean,
High as the heavens above,
Deep, deep as the deepest sea
Is my Saviour's love.
I though so unworthy
Still am a child of his care.
For his word teaches me,
That his love reaches me
Everywhere.

Jesus loved us, humanity, so much he died for us. He died for our wrongdoings. He took our pain we've done to ourselves and others, he became like a sheep to

the slaughter, he took my place, was substitute for me on the cross. He wants us to see his arms, outstretched. You don't have to worry about whether you will fit in, like a piece of furniture in a room. It's his love that reaches you. His love that fits you. His love that is for you. How will you respond this Easter to arms open wide? How will you respond to seeing Jesus' arms on the cross opened wide this Easter? Run away or draw closer and say: I am unworthy but I receive your love that reaches everywhere.

Paul, one of the followers of Jesus, writes to the church in Corinth, Our Master Jesus has his arms wide open for you. That includes you, dear reader. May you come and celebrate his love for you this Easter.






Psalm 31

LOOKING FORWARD TO SPRING



What we can look forward to seeing in Spring and What we will be sorry to see leave us to go back home to breed.

Short Eared Owls: will now return to Scandinavia and Iceland to pair up and breed. It is an unusual owl because it prefers to be out and about in the daytime. They can easily be spotted by their bright yellow eyes. Some do stay in in the UK but not in Norfolk.

Otters: will be wanting to breed again so the female will be chasing off her pups which are now fully grown and ready to look after themselves. A female Otter needs to eat half her body weight to stay healthy when she has young ones to feed. Their diet is mainly fish.

Hares: are mammals to look out for, like rabbits they are often associated with Springtime. They can be seen running around chasing each other and boxing as they try to find a mate. Their large ears have a black tip which sometimes is all you see from a distance.

Marsh Marigolds: The spring-flowering Marsh-marigold is a bright yellow, like a huge Buttercup. It is a widespread flower of ponds, marshes, damp meadows, ditches and damp woodland and is a conspicuous spring flower. It will brighten up any dark place. Look out for them when walking around.




